



## Round table discussion will be focused on

### *Consequences of genetic selection on physiological traits in poultry*

The round table aims to bring together science and practice to discuss:

- the latest trends and results on manipulations during chick embryogenesis in relation to the overall topic of the workshop, combined with actual problems and experience in large scale poultry industry, such as losses due to metabolic disorders, environmental stressors and others
- the environmental conditions during incubation – do they suit the 21<sup>st</sup> century embryos?

## Abstract Submission

Abstracts of the papers have to be submitted not later than the **June 1, 2009**. Abstracts must be written in English and should not exceed single page A4. For further instruction, please see the attachment (Format for Abstracts.doc).

Authors will be informed of the acceptance of their paper (as oral presentation or poster) not later than **July 1, 2009**.

## Venue

Slovakia is the member of the European Union, Eurozone (currency is Euro) and the Shengen area.

The workshop will be held in the Congress Centre Družba, Botanická 25, Bratislava, Slovak Republic. The centre is located in western part of Bratislava called Mlynska dolina and situated opposite the Faculty of Natural Sciences, where the welcome party will be held. It is not far from the city centre (four tram stops N° 1, 4, 9, 12) and in the same place is the Družba University Hotel\*\* (part of the university hostel of the same name).

## Travel information

Bratislava is easily accessible by plain. You can decide between the Bratislava Airport and closely situated Vienna Airport (with convenient bus connection to Bratislava every hour; trip lasting 50 min). There are also many train and bus connections; or even the boat service on a river Danube.
